



Recognizing Jesus as Our Savior


It is hard to believe that we have just finished celebrating Christmas, Epiphany, and the Season after Epiphany. And now we find ourselves approaching the season of Lent. Lent is the period of 40 days that comes before Easter. It is a time marked by reflection and preparation. The Bible tells us that Jesus spent 40 days and 40 nights in the wilderness. During this time Jesus was preparing for His mission, which began with the temptation by Satan and ended with His death on the cross when it would be revealed to all that Jesus is Savior. Our theme for Lent is: “Recognizing Jesus as Our Savior.”

Lent begins on Wednesday, February 17 with the observance of Ash Wednesday. This year due to the pandemic, Zion’s service will be held at 7 P.M. but *on Facebook only*. Ash Wednesday is an important worship experience for all Christians. The tradition of Ash Wednesday is that the ashes are from the charred remains of the palm branches from last year’s Palm Sunday. With a little bit of olive oil applied, these ashes are then placed on the forehead in the shape of a cross by a minister. When applying the ashes, the minister says, “Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return. Repent, and believe the gospel.” You will receive the set of ashes for your family on Saturday, February 13. With the ashes, you will receive a copy of the service. You can use the copy to follow along with the church’s Facebook service, or for those who do not have

access to Facebook, you can have your own service. I will bless the ashes before they are distributed.

In addition to Ash Wednesday, our Sunday services will focus on our understanding of what the word Savior means to us. We have many different views of what the word “Savior” means. We will explore these different views that shape our understanding of this word and the truth that we find in Scripture. Lastly, my hope and prayer is that we may realize that even as broken and sinful people we can be reconciled to a Holy God.

We will also provide a Bible Study using Zoom. You can either use your computer or your telephone to join in. The Bible Study will be on Wednesday evenings at 7 P.M. and Thursday afternoons at 2 P.M. The study is entitled “Savior: What the Bible Says About the Cross” by Magrey deVega. DeVega is senior pastor of Hyde United Methodist Church in Florida and the author of several Bible studies. The cost of the book is \$12. You can contact the office to order your book.



I pray you will join with me on this Lenten journey of Recognizing Jesus as Savior.


