

## UPDATE: RE-OPENING FOR WORSHIP

**As of Sun., November 8, 2020, Zion UMC is re-opened for indoor worship on Sundays at 11:00 a.m. in the Sanctuary.**

We will continue following CDC, state and local guidelines as well as those from our insurance company. Additionally, now that we are re-opened for indoor worship:

- ◆ First and foremost, if you are not comfortable returning to worship inside, don't. *God will not judge you, nor will your church family.* As Pastor Dave said, "You are still the church whether you are worshipping in person or through other means.
- ◆ If you do not feel well, or have any cold or flu-like symptoms, please stay home. If you have been exposed or think you may have, please stay home and call your doctor.
- ◆ Our Facebook Live and You Tube services as well as the weekly mailings will continue.
- ◆ Masks/face coverings are required at all times, including during the service.
- ◆ Temperatures will be checked and hand sanitizer will be provided upon entry in the elevator lobby and Glasgow Street entrances.  
***Please note that these will be the only two entrances open.***
- ◆ Social distancing will be practiced. Pews are marked off accordingly.
- ◆ Worship materials will continue to be emailed or mailed; please bring your own worship materials and/or Bibles to the service.
- ◆ Baskets will be available in the Sanctuary to place offerings.
- ◆ Praise & Prayer requests can be texted to 302-536-8136. They will be added to the next week's list.
- ◆ Communion will be celebrated on the first Sunday of each month following the appropriate precautions.

- ◆ The Food Pantry remains closed. Committees should continue to meet via Zoom.
